9. Assessment of recent changes (FPS / Induction)

FPS- New FPS limits according to gun class have been determined and posted on the forums. At recent games gun FPS has been checked and to date all compile. There has been only one application for use of an sniper SEG. This was granted.

Induction- Over the last couple of weeks there has been the introduction of inductions in order to better prepare new players for joining games. This covers basic safety, hit rules etc... following which they have been able to join the main game. There has been positive feed back from senior players that these new players are following the rules and putting into practice what they have learnt.

10. Assessment of promotional events

Waitakere push and play- Khamtanh with the help of other members attended this one day event in order to promote the club. He was able to secure funding from the event organisers that paid for 14 individual to be able to attend a game free of charge.

Gun show (27/10/08)- This is the 4th time ASA has attended this event. It has helped develop better relations with arms officers.

11. Team games

Recently ntrance (Sam) ran a very successful team based game day in which only experienced players were able to attend. Those brand new to the sport were unable to attend. This created a very different gaming environment in contrast to normal games.

Due to its success Mark recommended that more team based gaming events be run and proposed that every third game run or thereabouts be run as a team focussed event. No new players or inductions will be run. It is not critical that a player is part of a team as they can form one with other individuals on the day. However they will need to have played several games.

A team based game was originally proposed for the 15th November, but was not announced because it was found to later clash with a promotional event run the same weekend.

12. ASNZ Best practice Manual

ASNZ is currently in the process of putting together a Best practice manual. Basically it would cover everything about airsoft, rules, regulations, games etc... ASNZ have asked for help on this as the main person responsible for this is currently swamped by other projects. Oliver raised this at the ASA meeting and should we consider offering to help.
